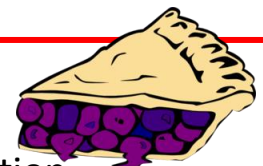
A portion of your dues goes to the Rolling Hills District and to GFWC-WI. It is very important we have everyone's dues in our treasury to meet these obligations.

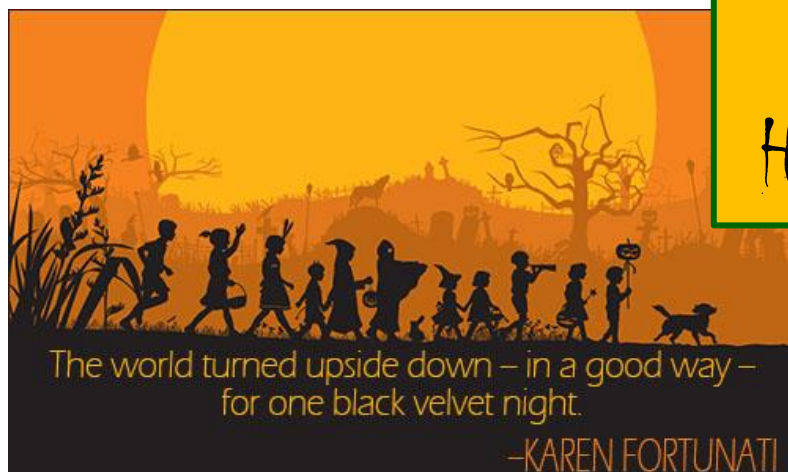
