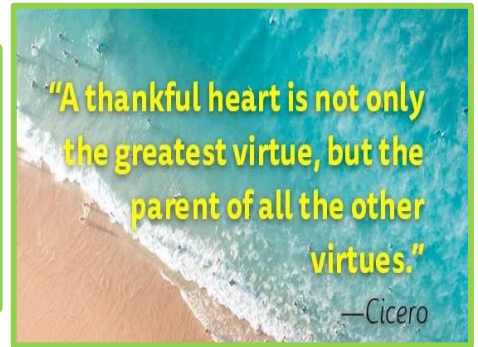




# The Woman's Club of Pewaukee

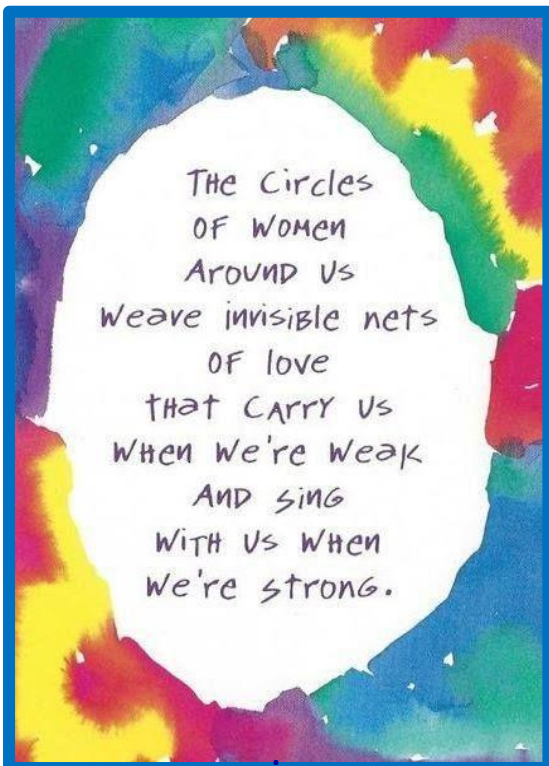
