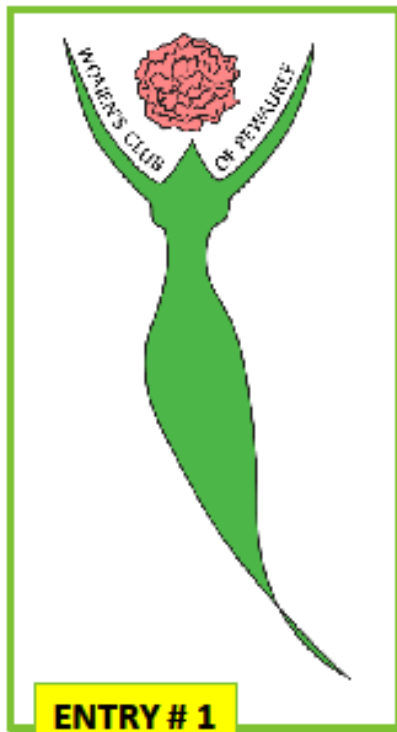

4	CURRENT LOGO (FUZZINESS DUE TO ENLARGING)	
5	WCP LETTERING W/GFWC-WI SYMBOLS FANNED OUT BELOW	
6	DIFFERENT TAKE ON CURRENT LOGO	
7	RIBBON BORDER W/GFWC-WI SYMBOLS	
8	WOMAN IN A SHELL	
9	WATERCOLOR SHELL	

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. You can vote for up to three entries.
2. If you vote for more than 1, you **MUST** number your choices - 1st thru 3rd  
Put the #1 in the box for your favorite entry.  
#2 for your second choice (you do not have to vote for a 2nd choice)  
#3 for your third choice (you do not have to vote for a 3rd choice.)
3. Points will be given to each number.  
#1 - 3 POINTS  
#2 - 2 POINTS  
#3 - 1 POINTS
4. The entry getting the most total votes will win.
5. To vote, you can either:

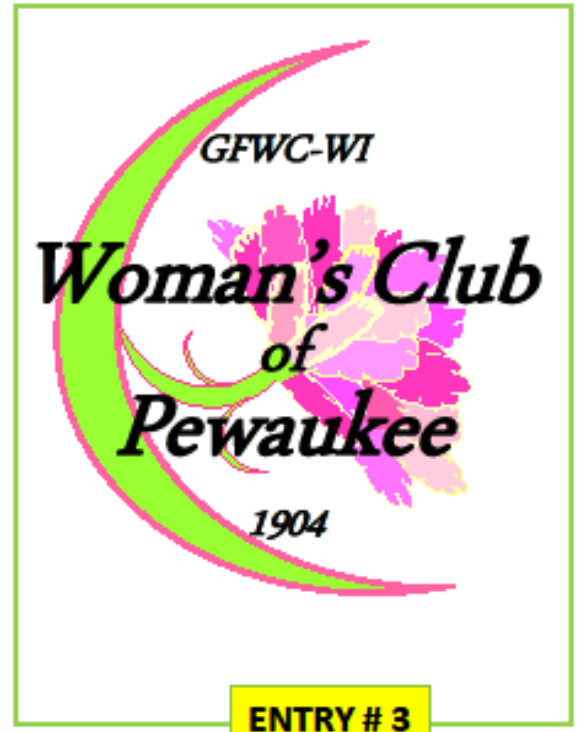
Carnation in woman's form/WCP name above outstretched arms. Font may be changed.

**ENTRY # 2**

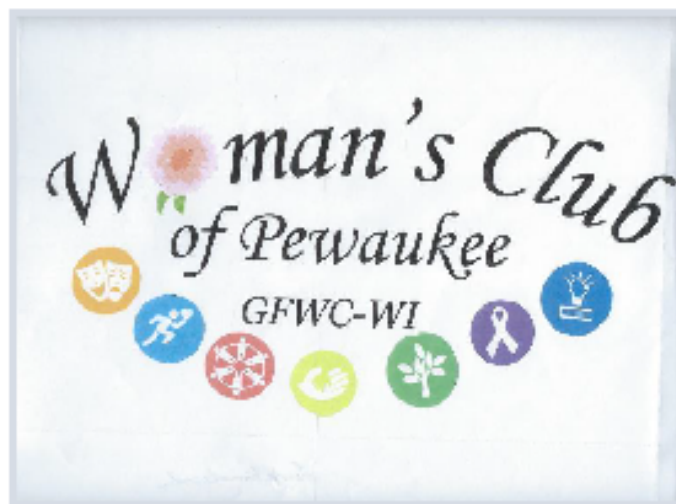
Carnation in woman's form/WCP name on woman's right side. Font may be changed

The color showing in the background is due to copying the entry. The background is pure white. The carnation would be outlined or brightened to stand out.

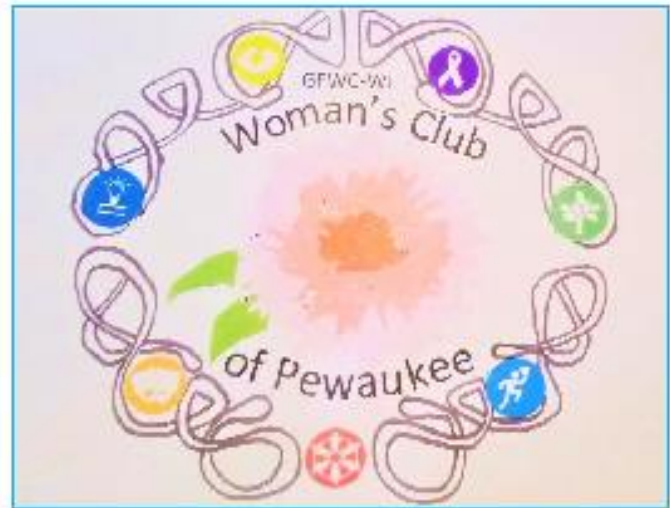


**ENTRY # 6**

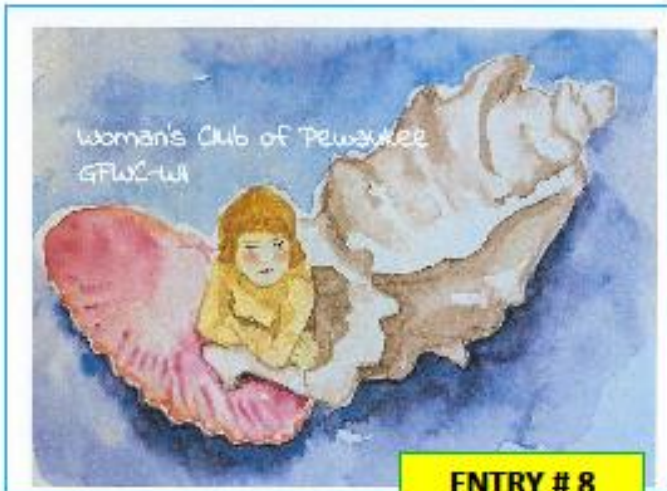
This entry is based on our current logo with modifications to colors, font, and flower shape.

GFWC-WI signature Program, Jr Club's Signature program, and the five GFWC-WI Community Service Programs.

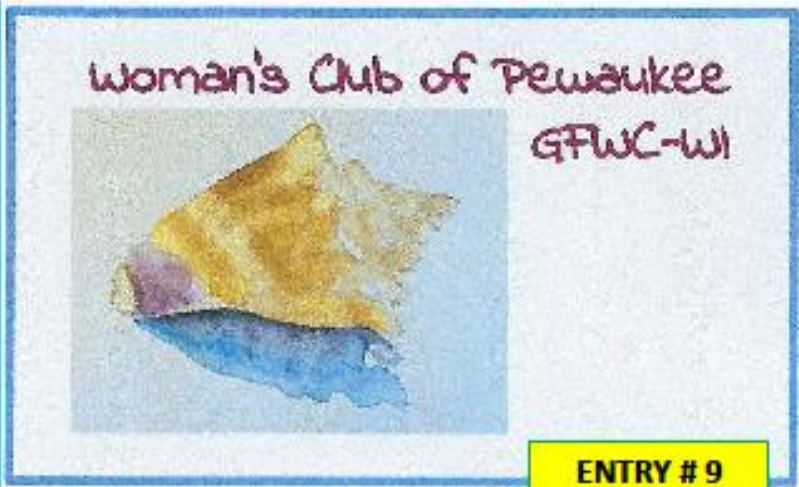
